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Literature Review

Satheesha H and Mallikarjun Vaddankere (2018) Library Resources and Services in the Selected Engineering College Libraries of Karnataka, India -A Survey" The present survey was aimed to study the condition of engineering college libraries in the context of resources, services and Library automation activities. To conclude, the Engineering college libraries need support from higher authorities in terms of constant financial support, trained personnel and better infrastructure, it may play a vital role in raising the efficiency in library services. With the advent of new technologies in every sphere of life, it has become mandatory in technical or non-technical academic institutions to access and check their strength and weakness. This comparative study of the libraries not only brought out their relative strengths and weaknesses, but also will serve as a launching pad for further in depth study.

Salubi, O.G. et. Al., (2018) carried out a study on "Utilization of Library Information Resources among Generation Z Students: Facts and Fiction". Generation Z was the foremost generation to have prevalent access to the Internet from an early age. The most utilized library resource was the Wi-Fi with e-books and e-journals found to be lowly utilized. Records from the E-librarians revealed that undergraduate students account for no more than 6% of total users of electronic databases with 62.3% of the respondents preferring print information resources. Better understanding of library users' demographics and information media preference was essential in proving the right kind of information services to Generation Z library users.

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Usage of Library Resources

Information utilization is the practical and maximum use of library resources identified and acquired by a user for the purpose of solving a problem or achieving a set goal. The printed resources are remaining crucial components of library system because of their completeness, accuracy, permanent accessibility and in-depth nature.

The electronic resources are stored electronically and made accessible through electronic systems and computer networks. These resources include OPAC, CD-ROMs, Online- Databases, E-journals E-books, Internet resources etc. Multiple accesses speed, richer in content, reuse,



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timeliness, anywhere access is some of the features of e-resources. IEEE Explore, Elsevier Science Direct, ASCE Journals, ASME Journals, EBSCO, Springer, etc. are the example of some famous e-resources available in India and overseas. These resources are paid resources and only accessible after payment. These are available in so many different packages in different price ranges. In India, these resources are available through INDEST-AICTE consortium and UGC-INFONET consortium also.

Need and Significance of the study:

Anna University launched constituent colleges throughout Tamil nadu to promote the higher education in the field of science and technology. This type of colleges helps the rural people and economically weaker people for their higher studies. The library community and user community should be aware of the importance of library resources and its use. The present study helps to identify the utility level of library resources. The study also helps to implement remedial measures to improve the status of the library and its users. So the researcher selected this area for the study.

Scope of the Study

The researcher has chosen Constituent College Library of Anna University, Dindigul. There is a well established library available in the campus.

The collected data will be analyzed with appropriate simple statistical techniques.

The researcher has selected only Anna University constituent college of Dindigul. The researcher selected only the Undergraduate final year students and staff.

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

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
